LEGOLAND Florida Resort I Winter Haven, FL

Offerings:

- BrickBeard's Watersport Stunt School (August 2023-present): Manages three thirty-minute shows per day
 calling each show with sound, pyro, flame, water, and boat cues during the eight-act show. The show involves
 working with a third-party ski group every day with 15 skiers per day, as well as two face performers and two
 animations performers. The manager must have a working knowledge of upwards of eleven contingencies, and
 nine different fall procedures.
- LEGOLAND Hotel Entertainment (July 2023-present): Oversees in a daily operation multiple offerings at the
 LEGOLAND Hotel. The venue includes ten Master Model Builder classes, three character meet and greets,
 four shows at the LEGOLAND Hotel Castle Stage, and four shows that happen simultaniously at the Pirate
 Island Hotel.
- Time To Learn (June 2023-present): Manages six 15 minute shows per day in an indoor playground area. The manager for the show also works as the technician and the usher. Tasks include running the show music and mixing the singers on Q-sys, dressing the stage before every show, striking it after every show, and keeping children off of the stage during the show.
- Lloyd's Elemental Challenge (January 2024-Febuary 2024): Managed four 25 minute shows per day during LEGOLAND's Ninjago Days 2024. The show involves four dancers, three marcial artists performing staged combat sequences with bo-staffs, swords, and spears, three trampoline artists, and one animation performer. The show uses elements such as flames, pyrotechnics, water cannons, snow machines, and more.
- School of Spinjitzu (January 2024-Febuary 2024): Managed five fifteen minute shows per day during LEGOLAND's Ninjago Days 2024. The manager for this show also works as the technician. Tasks include setting and striking the stage, including two guizers, running the music, and mixing the sound of the performers.
- Dragon's Drumbeat (January 2024-Febuary 2024): Managed six fifteen minute shows per day during LEGOLAND's Ninjago Days 2024. The show involved three drummers using multiple drum units and gongs.
- Academy of Holiday Cheer (November 2023-December 2023): Managed four twenty five minute shows in an
 outdoor venue for LEGOLAND's holiday event. The show involved two face characters, and one animations
 performer. The show involved audience participation and a post show meet and greet
